→ Candidates are required to register online on or before **26.07.2016** and take a printout in duplicate of Online Registration Form which shall be required at the time of registration in the Institute. Also a link shall be provided for **filling choices** for the **Creative Practice course**. It is mandatory for all registered candidates to study this course in the Semester-I. The choices for Creative Practice Courses are – 1) CP111: Music – Instrumental; 2) CP112: Music – Vocal; 3) CP113: Dance; 4) CP121: Painting; 5) CP122: Sculpture and 6) CP123: Advertising.

- * 1) **The Induction Programme is mandatory for all UGD/IDD/IMD students.**
 2) **There shall be a diagnostic test in Basic English on 27.07.2016 morning for those students, who scored less than 80% marks in English or for whom English was not an optional subject in the qualifying examination to test their reading, writing and comprehending abilities in English. Based on the result of the test, some students would be asked to register for “Basic English” course so that they do not have any problem in understanding the lectures.**
