Applications are invited from Indian nationals who are residents of Uttar Pradesh for the post of Junior Research Assistant (JRA) at a fellowship of Rs. 25,000/ per month for 1st two years and Rs.28,000/ per month for 3rd year in the project entitled “*Precise inference of the Galactic helium-to-metal enrichment ratio using asteroseismology*” sponsored by Council of Science & Technology, Uttar Pradesh (CSTUP), Lucknow. This post is purely temporary and co-terminus with the project.

Essential eligibility for Junior Research Assistant (JRA)

- The candidate must be a resident of Uttar Pradesh.
- The upper age limit is 28 years as on 1st April 2024.
- The candidate must hold an M.Sc. degree in Physics, Astronomy, Computer Science, or a related field with a 1st division in both graduate and postgraduate examinations, or a B.E./B.Tech. or equivalent degree with 1st division.

Desirable: Preference will be given to candidates with NET/GATE qualification and to those with experience in Astronomy and numerical computation.
