(a) the details of initiatives undertaken by the Government to support all 22 scheduled Indian languages through AI-based language platforms such as Bhashini and BharatGen;

Reply: Under the mission Bhashini, IIT(BHU), Varanasi, is involved in two research projects. These projects cover Hindi, Tamil, Sanskrit, and English. The following are the details of the research projects:

Language Communicator Tool for End Users: For multilingual Natural Language Generation (NLG), this project is developing a Universal Semantic Representation (USR), which is universal, computationally tractable, unambiguous, and explicit. This representation is motivated by the Indian Grammatical Tradition (IGT). It captures the meaning or thought in a speaker/author's mind. The objective is to generate multiple natural languages using Natural Language Generators. Currently, its focus is on Hindi, Tamil, and English.

Sanskrit Knowledge Accessor: The objective of this Project is

A) to develop Sanskrit-Hindi, Sanskrit-English, and Sanskrit-Tamil accessors, with the following three applications:

- i) Ayurveda reading aid for Vaidyas,
- ii) Darshana or classics reading aid for popularization among the reading public, such as the Upanishads and the Mahābhārata, and
- iii) Objective-type question-answering system on Bhāvaprakāśa Nighanṭu (BPN)

B) To generate high-quality linguistically rich annotated data semi-automatically

C) To explore the traditional knowledge in Mīmāṃsā, and other literature on the theories of verbal cognition for understanding the discourse structure

(b) the scope of digitisation of linguistic data, development of multilingual tools and creation of open language datasets under these initiatives;

Reply: The scope of digitisation of linguistic data, development of multilingual tools and creation of open language datasets under these initiatives includes:

1. Development of a Universal Semantic Representation (USR) for multilingual Natural Language Generation (NLG), which involves digitising linguistic data and creating computationally tractable, unambiguous semantic representations.
2. Building multilingual tools such as Natural Language Generators that can produce output in Hindi, Tamil, and English (and extending to Sanskrit).
3. Creation of open language datasets through the generation of high-quality, linguistically rich annotated data semi-automatically, specifically for Sanskrit-based accessors (Sanskrit-Hindi, Sanskrit-English, Sanskrit-Tamil).
4. Application of these datasets and tools for various linguistic and cultural projects like Ayurveda reading aids, Darshana classics, and objective-type question-answering systems.
