→ You are required to do profile registration online on or before **24.07.2018** and take a printout in duplicate of Online Profile Registration Form which shall be required at the time of registration in the Institute. The URL for online profile registration is https://www.iitbhu.ac.in/acad/admissions/entrants/online_registration. The profile registration portal shall be opened on 20.07.2018 at 10.00 A.M. Also a link shall be provided for **filling choices** for the **Creative Practice course**. It is mandatory for all registered candidates to study this course in the Semester-I. The choices for Creative Practice Courses are – 1) CP111: Music – Instrumental; 2) CP112: Music – Vocal; 3) CP113: Dance; 4) CP121: Painting; 5) CP122: Sculpture and 6) CP123: Advertising. You will also fill the “Information for Medical Emergency Form” available online.

- * 1) **The Induction Programme is mandatory for all UGD/IDD students.**
 2) **There shall be a diagnostic test in Basic English on 25.07.2018 morning for those students, who have scored less than 80% marks in English or for those who did not opt English as an optional subject in the qualifying examination to test their reading, writing and comprehending abilities in English. Based on the result of the test, students would be asked to register for “Basic English” course to avoid any problem in understanding the lectures.**
