1. Eminent Alumni of various departments:

Eminent Alumni of the Mechanical Engineering Department recognized nationally and internationally:

- A. Prof. Suhas Pandurang Sukhatme : was born to indumati Sukhatme and Pundurang Vasudeo Sukhatme, renowned statistician and a Padma Bhushan award winner, on 5 November 1938 a Baroda in the Western Indian State of Maharashtra. He graduated in Engineering in 1958 from the Banaras Hindu University and pursued his higher studies at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He secured a master's degree (SM) in 1964. He became the director of the IIT Bombay in 1995, he held the post till he retired in 2000. Post retirement from IIT Mumbai, he worked as the chairman of Atomic Energy Regulatory Board of the Government of India form 2000 till 2005.

- C. Mr. Krishna Kant Parashar: Graduated from IIT-BHU in 1971 in Mechanical Engineering He also did PGDBM (Finance) from Rajasthan University. He served in Rajasthan Financial Corporation (RFC- a state government undertaking), Jaipur for about 35 Years dealing in project appraisal and finance of small and medium enterprises (SMEs) and retired as General Manager. He also worked as president of Local Branch of Mahanmana Malaviya Mission.
- D. Dr. Sandeep Pandey: Dr. Sandeep Pandey is an alumnus of the Institute of Technology, Banaras Hindu University. Thereafter he did his Master's in manufacturing and computer science from Syracuse University, followed by a doctorate in control theory at the University of California, Berkeley, which he completed in 1992. After completing his education, he moved back to India and started teaching at Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur in 1992 and later founded a registered organization named Asha Trust which currently has several centres/chapters across India. His team has launched a people's group named Asha Parivar in 2008 that focuses on strengthening democracy at the grassroots in Hardoi district of Uttar Pradesh.
- E. Mr. Satich Kumar Agrawal, Chairman & Managing Director Kamdhenu Ispat Limited: Mr. Agrawal, a graduate in Mechanical Engineering from BENCO, Banaras Hindu University has distinguished himself as a man of caliber, dynamism and enthusiasm,

when he floated Kamdhenu Ispat Limited in 1994 and took over as its Chairman & Managing Director. Prior to that, he was partner, Arya Krishi Yantra Udyog Shala, (1970-1974), Director, Muzaffarnagar Refectories Pvt Ltd. Mr. Agrawal is one of the outstanding Chief Executives of the Steel Industry of India Today.

- F. Dr. S. K. Maini, Founder, Maini Group: Dr. Maini is a graduate in Mechanical Engineering from BENCO, Banaras Hindu University (1954). He started his carrier as Covenanted Officer & Production Administrator, Guest Keen Williams Ltd (1958-1963), General work Manager, Precision Fasteners Limited (1965-67), General Production Manager, MICO-BOSCH (1967-73). Dr. Maini Started Maini Industrial Consultations in 1973 which for first 10 years did lot of consultative assignment and now looks after various assignments of Maini Group. He also started Maini Precision products as a single unit which 10 people in Bangalore, which is now converted into Maini Group spanning over 14 locations in and around Bangalore having 2500 highly trained workforce. The group is involved in manufacturing precision automotive and aerospace components which are supplying mostly to Europe and America.
- G. Dr. Kota Harinarayana (born 1943, in Brahmapur, Odisha) was the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Hyderabad and the President of the Aeronautical Society of India. He is an alumnus of the Institute of Technology, Banaras Hindu University and Indian Institute of Science (master's in Aero Engineering) and IIT Bombay (PhD). - C. **Narala Tata Rao:** (4 September 1917-April 2007) was a prominent person in the power sector of India and a former Chairman of the Andhra Pradesh State Electricity Board.

Born 4 September 1917

Died 7 April 2007 (aged 90)

Tata Rao was born on 4 September 1917 in Kowtharam in Krishna district. After early education in Andhra, he graduated in engineering from Banares Hindu University in 1941 and obtained MS in power systems engineering from the Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago, IL.

Tata Rao built the Madhya Pradesh State Electricity Board from scratch in 1958. The late K.L. Rao appointed him as Member (Thermal) of the Central Water and Power Commission (CWPC) in 1972. However, Jalagam Vengala Rao spared no efforts to get Tata Rao to the State in August 1974. Tata Rao became synonymous with the energy sector in Andhra Pradesh. He increased the installed capacity of the State grid five-fold by conceiving giant generation projects like Vijayawada Thermal Station, Nagarjunasagar, Srisailem and Lower Sileru.

He formed a strong base for the State's electricity sector, which is now considered one of the best in the country. He won several awards at national and international levels, including Padma Shri(1983).

D. Rajiv Dogra:

Born: 1948

Alma mater: IIT (BHU)

Rajiv Dogra is an [Indian](#) diplomat, television commentator, writer and an artist. He was the Indian Ambassador to Italy and Romania and [Consul General](#) to [Karachi, Pakistan](#). He was also India's Permanent Representative to the United Nations Agencies based in Rome. He has advised a government on restructuring its foreign ministry and has sat on the advisory boards of multinational corporations.

Rajiv Dogra started his career with the [Indian Foreign Service](#) in 1974, following a degree in electrical engineering from [Benares Hindu University](#) (Now [Indian Institute of Technology \(BHU\) Varanasi](#)). He began his career with a posting at the [Indian Embassy in Stockholm, Sweden](#), and rose to national and international prominence during his tenure as Consul General of India in [Karachi, Pakistan]. It was one of the most tense period in the [Indo-Pak] relations in the aftermath of [Babri] incident and the serial bomb blasts in [Bombay] in 1993. The [Indian Consulate General] in [Karachi] has remained closed after Rajiv Dogra completed his tenure there.

E. Manick Sorcar (formal name Prafulla Chandra "P.C." Sorcar) is an [Indian American](#) artist, animator, engineer, and laserist based in [Denver, Colorado](#), United States.

Sorcar is an award-winning artist^[1] in various media, including fine arts, cartoons, animations, laser arts, and world-touring stage shows with live action mixed with laser animation. His animated films, all based on children's stories from India, have won prestigious awards at international film festivals and been broadcast on the [Public Broadcasting Service](#) for 22 years.^[2] He first shot to fame in the nineties when his *Deepa & Rupa: A Fairy Tale from India*, India's first animation mixed with live action, received the Gold Plaque at the [Chicago International Film Festival](#) in 1990, and *The Sage and the Mouse* won the Gold Medal at the International Film Festival of New York^[3] in 1993. After this, his *Calcutta Forever: A Laser Fantasy* was recorded as the first laser-documentary screened inside a movie theatre. In 2000, he received the *Excellence in Art Plaque* from the National Federation of Indian American Associations in New Jersey, for his laser shows *Dancing with My Soul* and *India Forever*. Hosted by the Indian Consulate General of San Francisco for India's 61st [Republic Day](#) celebration on January 26, 2010, his laser documentary *Our Republic's Birth*, which captured India's history starting from 3300 BCE to its independence from the British and proclamation as a Republic Dominion was shown at the historic [Palace of Fine Arts](#) in [San Francisco, California](#).^[4]

In 2012 he produced Swamiji, a laser documentary on Swami Vivekananda, which was praised by the critics, Ramakrishna Missions and Vedanta Societies around the world for its accurate depiction of Swami Vivekananda's life. The Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math, Howrah, India said "It was as if he was painting the events of Swamiji's life with a paintbrush before our eyes. It was fascinating." about the show which took place on 31 January 2014 at Belur Math campus, attended by 15,000 people.[5]

Sorcar is the first Indian-American to receive the ILDA Artistic Award twice from the International Laser Display Association. The first[6] was in 2006 for his Enlightenment of Buddha, which mixed live-performance with life-size laser animation and three-dimensional visual effects on stage and won the First Place at the 2005 International Laser Display Association award contest. The second[7] was in 2008, for his laser-art Reflection, which also won First Place for laser photography at the 2007 ILDA award contest.

In 2012, Sorcar retired from Sorcar Engineering,[8] a Denver-based electrical engineering and lighting firm which did the lighting design for the Denver International Airport concourses, sport centers in Japan, and several Saudi Arabian palaces. He retired from engineering in order to devote himself full-time to his art productions. As an author in the field of electrical engineering, he has written several popular lighting design texts. He received his M.S. in Electrical Engineering from the University of Washington and his B.S. in Electrical Engineering from Banaras Hindu University (now Indian Institute of Technology, BHU).[9]

Sorcar's art and animation have been the subject of numerous articles, academic research papers,[10] and books. For his simultaneous contribution to art and science, he was acclaimed as "the Renaissance Man of our time" in the book *Voices of Colorado: Perspectives of Asian Americans* (ISBN 0615202136) by Nestor Mercado, Elnora Minoza-Mercado, and Alok Sarwal. In 2009, he was the subject of the book *World of Manick Sorcar: Where Art Becomes Magic* (ISBN 1607252899), by Roma Sur,[11] and in 2010 *East Meets West: The Animation of Manick Sorcar* (ISBN 0578054043), by Wendy Luna.[12]

Sorcar has received a number of honors, including the Bharat Samman Achievers Award[13] at the XXI Annual Meet NRI Divas 2011 of the NRI Institute in New Delhi. In 2011, Jadavpur University opened the Manick Sorcar Laser Animation Laboratory. Sorcar donated laser lab equipment worth more than US\$100,000 and introduced the first laser animation course at the university as a special application of lighting for degrees in illumination engineering.[14]

On 6 November 2013, at Aalen, Germany, he was bestowed with the Special Achievement Award for Cultural Enlightenment from the International Laser Display Association for exceptional merit in using laser display to celebrate India's heritage, and to prepare the next generation by introducing a course on laser art and animation and establishing the Manick Sorcar Laser Animation Laboratory at Jadavpur University.[15]

On 24 May 2014, at New Delhi, India, he received the IIT-BHU Alumni Lifetime Achievement Award for Outstanding Contributions in the Field of Cultural and Enlightenment through Science and Arts.[16]

Sorcar is the eldest son of legendary Indian magician, the late P.C. Sorcar.[17] As a young man, he helped his father create unique lighting effects for his world-touring magic shows, but never took up stage magic as a profession as he was more interested in doing his own brand of magic with art and lighting. He is married to Shikha Sorcar, and has two daughters, Piya and Payal.
