NOTIFICATION

(About the B.Tech./B.Arch./IDD students admitted in 2020)

Considering the academic interests and the well being of students (new entrants), the Institute has made the following decisions for the COVID-19 affected admissions/commencement of classes for the first semester of new entrants.

1. Academic Calendar:

The academic calendar for B.Tech./B.Arch./IDD students admitted in 2020 is enclosed as Annexure-I. Teaching will be done using online mode for the odd semester 2020-21. Mode of teaching in even semester 2020-21 for B.Tech./B.Arch./IDD students admitted in 2020 will be decided later on.

2. Courses with laboratory component:

While it is encouraged to complete laboratory courses/laboratory components of courses using online mode, some courses may require compulsory physical involvement. Considering covid-19 outbreak subsequent online teaching-learning, laboratory components of many courses of first semester of B.Tech./B.Arch./IDD may not be completed remotely. It is proposed to split such courses into separate theory and laboratory courses as a special provision for students admitted If the laboratory component is not evaluated, grades of only theory part will be awarded. Theory component of a course should not be deferred; if absolutely required, a prior approval is necessary. For example:

It is further suggested that the Department/School should inform Academic Section about their plan about laboratory courses/ courses with laboratory component. If deferred of odd semester 2020-21, a plan for completing the course during even semester 2020-21 should also be intimated to academic section as soon as possible.

- 3. Creative practice courses of first year: CP course is a non-graded course. It will be deferred from odd semester 2020-21 for 2020 admission batch. The decision about offering the CP Course will be reviewed again.
- 4. PE 101 (Elementary Physical Education) courses of first year: PE 101 course is a non-graded course. It will be deferred from odd semester 2020-21 of 2020 admission batch. The decision about offering the PE Course will be reviewed again.

5. Evaluation during odd semester 2020-21 for students admitted in 2020:

The evaluation pattern for the odd semester 2020-21 for students admitted in 2020 will be as follows:

6. Branch Change Guidelines

The branch change of students is decided based on their performance in Institute Science & Institute Engineering courses. Many such courses of the first semester of BTech/IDD have laboratory components which may not be completed remotely. Considering this fact, it may be difficult to do branch change after 1st semester with partial evaluation. Considering the evaluation of the current covid-19 situation, we may optimistically consider that the students will be able to complete their all graded courses by the end of second semester. Thus, it is logical to defer the branch change till completion of the second semester. As a special case B.Tech/IDD students admitted in 2020, will have one opportunity of branch change after 2nd semester. All other rules of branch change will remain unchanged and will be applicable.

However, branch changed students after 2nd semester may have to clear more overload as a requirement of the new branch. Any pending courses may hamper internship/placement opportunities of these students. Thus, to minimize number of overloads that students need to clear after branch change, the following was recommended:

If a student has taken PHY101 in the old branch and the new branch has requirement of PHY102 but not PHY101 or if a student has taken PHY102 in the old branch and the new branch has requirement of PHY101 but not PHY102, these two courses will be considered equivalent for such branch change students.

If a student has taken MA101 in the old branch and the new branch has requirement of MA102 but not MA101 or if a student has taken MA102 in the old branch and the new branch has requirement of MA101 but not MA102, these two courses will be considered equivalent for such branch change students.

Requirement of BL101 in the new branch may be waived if a student has taken CY101 in old branch and vice versa.

Requirement of EO101 in the new branch may be waived if a student has taken EO102 in old branch and vice versa.

Summer term is usually offered for only final year students. However, as a special case, summer term 2020-21 (May-July 2021) will also be offered for these branch change students to clear their pending requirements of new branch in online/physical mode.

(PHY101: Physics - I: Classical, Quantum & Relativistic Mechanics; PHY102: Physics - II: Introduction to Engineering Electromagnetics; MA101: Engineering Mathematics - I; MA102: Engineering Mathematics - II; BL101: Biology; CY101: Chemistry - I; EO101: Fundamentals of Electrical Engineering; EO102: Fundamentals of Electronics & Instrumentation Engineering)

All the aforementioned decisions related to B.Tech./B.Arch./IDD students of 2020-21 batch have been made as a special provision for this year only and will have no precedence for future batches, unless and until approved by the Competent Authority.
