


Institute Updates



1. On 31st August, 2022, IIT (BHU) signed an MoU with the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) to establish a Center of Excellence for Tunneling and Underground Space Engineering, to help with the development of rapid transport and border defense infrastructure. It will operate in two hubs for effective functioning: one hub in IIT (BHU), Varanasi, and another in Delhi Metro Rail Academy. DMRC will offer short-term training programs to train field engineers and construction supervisors, while IIT (BHU), with its complementary expertise in various engineering domains, will be extremely valuable for in-project planning, innovative designs, safety measurements, structural health monitoring, and retrofiting. The Institute will also offer UG minor/major courses as well as PG courses for the same.



2. IIT (BHU), Varanasi and National Institute of Industrial Engineering, Mumbai, conducted the concluding session of the Global Online Certification Course on Data-Driven Supply Chain Transformation 2022, in association with Prof. David Simchi-Levi (MIT, USA), and under the leadership of Prof. Manoj Tiwari (Director, NITIE) and Prof. Pramod Kumar Jain (Director, IIT (BHU) and Director, I-DAPT Hub Foundation, IIT (BHU), Varanasi). The event was graced by Sh. Rajesh Aggrawal, IAS Officer (Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship), and Sh. Akhilesh Tuteja (Global Head, Cyber Security-KPMG) as the keynote speaker. A total of more than 1600 individuals from 84+ prestigious national and international organizations have participated proactively in the course. The course included participants from more than six countries, including the USA, UAE, Canada, Germany, South Korea, and Spain.



3. Team AVERERA of IIT (BHU), Varanasi, has once again brought laurels to the Institute and the nation by ranking 3rd globally and 1st in Asia-Pacific & Middle-east in Shell Eco-Marathon 2022. One of the top student engineering competitions in the world, the Shell Eco-Marathon is an international event with an emphasis on energy optimization. It aims to provide cleaner energy solutions through electric vehicles. This year, 157 teams from 37 countries participated. Team AVERERA will receive prize money of US \$4750 from Shell. The EV made by AVERERA is made up of carbon fiber and is extremely lightweight. As per simulation results, the vehicle will approximately give a mileage of 200 Km/kWh.



4. IDAPT Hub Foundation, IIT (BHU) conducted the finals of the national level mega event for startups, the 'I-DAPT Hub Pitch Challenge', on 22nd and 23rd August, 2022. The event marked the celebration of Azaadi ka Amrit Mahotsav at IIT (BHU), Varanasi. This program is under the aegis of the National Mission on Interdisciplinary Cyber Physical Systems. Top 24 startups from all over India working in thrust areas of Power, Defence, Healthcare, Telecommunications, and Road, Transport & Highways, competed for the cash prizes worth Rs. 5 lakh, and winners/runner-ups of the event got direct entry into the screening round of Incubation process. Startups exhibited their products/services using cutting-edge technologies at the 'Start-up Expo'.



Performing better with every passing year, the Institute witnessed stellar performance this internship season with dedicated efforts of the Training and Placement Cell. A total of 352 paid internship offers and 253 Pre-Placement Offers (PPO) have been bagged by the students in reputed companies like Microsoft, Google, Goldman Sachs, Sprinklr, Procter and Gamble, De Shaw, Salesforce, Uber, and many more till 30th August, 2022, with the number still increasing.

The highest PPO and internship stipend offered was Rs. 91,18,716/- per annum and Rs. 2,50,000/- per month, respectively, with the average being Rs. 28,11,268/- per annum and Rs. 1,10,210/- per month respectively. Team AVERERA

Team AVERERA participated in the Shell Eco-Marathon 2022 and has brought accolades to the Institute and the nation by ranking 3rd globally and 1st in the Asia Pacific and the Middle East among 157 teams from 37 countries. The team won 1st place in Pitch the Future, Simulate to Innovate Off-track award, and the Shell Eco-Marathon Quiz. Their vehicle is made of carbon fibre material to minimise body weight without compromising driver safety. It is highly aerodynamic, ergonomic and lightweight as electric efficiency is the goal of the competition. Team AVERERA has designed and manufactured the motor-controllers in-house to increase the efficiency.



Ideation Innovation & Incubation Foundation

Ideation Innovation & Incubation Foundation (I3F), a section 8 company, is an umbrella organization at IIT (BHU), Varanasi. It provides 'Start to Scale' support for entrepreneurship and facilitates research activities to convert into commercial ventures. It aims to develop regional competitiveness, enhancing links between universities and research institutions, and contributing to the growth of emerging technology businesses.



Recently, a sum of Rs. 46 lakh was disbursed to 10 startups (6 seed stage, 4 pre-seed stage) of COHORT - 1&2 as the second tranche to achieve their respective proposed milestones. Sh. Subodh Shah, the founder of M/S Frenzy Farm LLP, was awarded 'Uttarakhand Gaurav Samman - 2022' by the Agriculture Minister of Uttarakhand on 30th August, 2022.

Students' Updates

E-Cell IIT BHU conducted 'Impact Sessions', a series of four lectures that covered a wide range topics, delivered by professors from IITs and IIMs, and industry experts. The final round of an idea generation event, named 'Start-Bucks' was concluded, which saw a participation of more than 400 students. The team also helped organize the finale for I-DAPT Hub Pitch Challenge, a national-level pitching event. The Startup Helpbook is an initiative launched to provide students that are interested in startups with free resources, across the nation. Starting from Idea Generation, the multiple editions cover everything till Exit Strategy.



The Student Counseling Services recently launched the WellM app, co-founded by our alumnus, Sh. Rakesh Sarin (CHE '76), as an official wellness partner of IIT (BHU) alongside YourDost. Witnessing a turnout of more than 160 students, the session covered the importance of physical, mental, emotional, and overall well-being of the students,



along with a guide given by Sh. Rakesh about the important features of the app. Continuing their Flagship series of Acing Placements, sessions were conducted for the Consulting and Data Science domains, with recent alumni as the guest speakers to help provide students with the right guidance for their placements.

Alumni Updates

SAIC continued with its flagship 'Student Alumni Mentorship Program', conducting sessions on 'Research' and 'Core' as a part of its Weekly Panel Discussion series, with experienced alumni talking about the skills required to succeed in the respective domains. The internship drive of the second edition of the



'Alumni-Guided Mock Interviews' initiative by SAIC was successfully completed. The students got a chance to experience one-on-one mock interviews with our esteemed alumni. With 480+ students and 100+ alumni volunteers registered, more than 520 mock interviews were successfully conducted.

Dr. Jay Prakash (ECE '13) is the founder and CEO of Silence Laboratories, a web-focused startup that works with cybersecurity. There has just been an announcement of funding of US \$1.7M to Silence Laboratories by pi Ventures.



BrightChamps a global edtech platform founded by Sh. Ravi Bhushan (CSE '05) acquired Schola, a Singapore based live-learning platform for kids to master communication and English skills, in a US \$15M cash & stock deal.
